ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Academic good standing (GPA Minimum 2.3)
- Milwaukee County and surrounding area high school senior, full-time status in an accredited high school
- Declared intention to enroll in a four-year accredited college or university, two-year community college or accredited business or vocational school
- Two letters of recommendation (original letter/signature required). Such letters of recommendation may come from one of the following: community leader, church or academic leader; a non-profit or profit organization (i.e. place of employment if applicable) or from any leader who is willing to complete a letter of recommendation based upon your services and contributions of one year or more to their organization.
- A 3X5 300 DPI digital (graduation headshot preferred). The photo will not be returned. Cellular phone photos WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED
- Student official transcript with school seal
- Documentation demonstrating extracurricular activities and community service.

Joel J Kinlow

Joel J Kinlow was born into a large family of 11 children in Pickens, Arkansas. His life began with the odds against him. He was an African American (birth certificate reads Negro) born in the South to a Mother and Father with minimum education.

At an early age, his family moved to Dumas, Arkansas, where he attended public school and worked in the family's farming business. Like his Father, Joel was born to be an entrepreneur. Whenever he was not in school or assisting his Father on the farm, Joel would work for a local newspaper, *The Grit*, and during his free time selling various food items; such as candy, watermelons, and bakery. Shortly after graduating from high school and serving in the military, he was employed by American Motors and Allis Chambers. He was the first African American route salesman for The Coca-Cola Company in the city of Milwaukee. Eventually, he decided to establish his own business. He refused to let anyone define him; instead, with God, he determined his goals.

With no formal degree, this Dumas Colored School graduate became a brilliant, formidable, and well-respected businessman in the state of Wisconsin. In 1965, he opened Kinlow Laundry & Dry Cleaning and operated that business until 1974. He decided to open Kinlow Real Estate Investments, successfully owning more than 35 properties in the Milwaukee Area.

He began a nine-year process of fulfilling requirements to build his television station from the ground up. His persistence and hard work paid off. In 1990, the doors of WJJA TV-49 opened. However, his ultimate dream was to bring 24-hour Gospel music to Milwaukee. In May of 1995, he purchased WGLB AM 1560 and WGLB FM 100.1. He changed the format to all Gospel music in August 1996 for AM 1560 while simultaneously establishing other successful media ventures in the South. Joel was also the proprietor of Children's Trinity Day Care, Dollar J Store, and WGLB Records in Milwaukee, WI.

Joel always surpassed what was expected of him, despite what some may deem limitations, his place of birth, education, and lack of formal industry or corporate experience. In keeping with his Biblical upbringing and personal convictions, Joel was also Pastor Kinlow, serving as a pastor for over 35 years under the Church Of God In Christ, Inc.

In keeping with Joel's legacy, Joel left behind his widow, four children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren. The WGLB Scholarship in his memory was established in 2016 after Pastor Kinlow's transition. This scholarship was created to assist individuals, such as Pastor Kinlow, who desire to receive a secondary education.

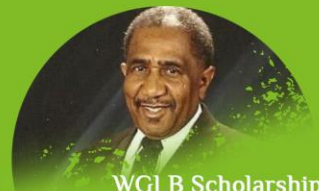
